

Rules of "Chelsea Comes to Yarpole" Photographic Competition 2019

1. The competition is open to all amateur photographers. For the purposes of this competition, an amateur photographer will be considered to be someone who makes less than half their annual income from the sale of their photographs.
2. There will be two classes of entry:
 - a. Adult – aged 16 or over on 7 June 2019
 - b. Junior – aged below 16 on 7 June 2019
3. The competition will comprise the following categories:

1 Single Bloom	6 Seasons
2 Close-up or Macro	6a Spring Promise
3 Favourite Yarpole Garden	6b Summer Bounty
4 Favourite Herefordshire Garden	6c Autumn Colour
5 It's a bug's life – plant with insect(s)	6d Winter Wonder
4. Entrants may submit one photograph for each category for which they are eligible.
5. Post Processing of photographs is acceptable, for example cropping, adjustment of colour, tone and exposure but photo-montages combining separate images is not.
6. Entries must be colour or black and white prints, mounted or unmounted, with overall dimensions not exceeding 30cm x 21cm.
7. Winning entrants must be prepared to submit a digital copy of their winning entry suitable for printing at A4 size.
8. Photographs may have been taken at any time and at any location within the UK, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man. The location at which each entry was photographed must be provided.
9. Entries must be received by midnight 2nd June 2019 and should be delivered to Yarpole Community Shop, St Leonard's, Green Lane, Yarpole HR6 0BD.
10. Entries must be submitted with a separate note of the entrant's name, telephone number, preferred email address and approximate location of residence, eg Yarpole or Ludlow. These details should not be visible on the displayed print.
11. Names of entrants will not be made available to the judge(s) until after winning entries have been selected.
12. The winning entries will be identified as part of the display at St Leonard's. Individual notifications will not be issued.
13. There will be a display of submitted images in St Leonard's Church from 7 June for a period of (at least) one week.
14. Copyright in all images will remain with the entrants but the organisers retain the right to use any submitted image for the purposes of publicising the competition and/or promoting the Parish of Croft and Lucton with Yarpole. Winning images will be printed in The Parishoner, subject to available space, and will be displayed on Yarpole.com and Facebook.
15. Entry to the competition is free and there will be no prizes.
